You may wear only the proper combination of Palms for the number of merit badges you earned beyond the rank of Eagle. The Bronze Palm represents five merit badges, the Gold Palm 10, and the Silver Palm 15.

NOTES:

For Venturers working on Scouts BSA requirements, replace "troop" with "crew" and "Scoutmaster" with "Crew Advisor."

For Sea Scouts working on Scouts BSA requirements, replace "troop" with "ship" and "Scoutmaster" with "Skipper."

- .14 Eagle Palms must be earned in sequence, and the three-month tenure requirement must be observed for each Palm.

 (This does not apply to palms earned concurrent with the Eagle Scout rank.)
- .15 Merit badges earned any time since joining Scouts BSA may be used to meet this requirement.
